Why study Quran?

Hadhrat Uthman (RA) narrates that Rasulullah (SAW) said:

"The best amongst you is he who learns the Quran and teaches it."

(Bukhari, Abu Daud, Tirmidzi, Nasa'i, Ibnu Majah)

Why study Arabic?

Arabic is sacred: it is the language of the Quran, the language of the Prophet Muhammad (Allah bless him and give him peace), and the language of authoritative scholarly works in every religious discipline.

Muslims have been learning Arabic for centuries with this sacred goal in mind. Non-Arab Muslims—such as the Turks, the Persians, and the Indians—have formulated rigorous methods of teaching their children Arabic so that they can directly access sacred religious texts mainly the Holy Quran and their wording while prayer (solat) and supplication (do'a). These methods have stood the test of time and produced thousands of top-notch scholars.

Tajweed Course

Course Coordinator: Br. Ikhwan Zaki

Tajweed (Quran Recitation) is an Arabic word meaning proper pronunciation during recitation, as well as recitation at a moderate speed. It is a set of rules which govern how the Quran should be read. It is derived from the trilateral root j-w-d, meaning to make well, make better and perfect.

The course will focus on the recitation and the proper pronunciation of the students. The tutor will also encourage the students to develop their awareness about understanding the verses they read.

Tahfeez Course
